USF Pro Championships Presented by Continental Tire is the world's leading driver development program providing a scholarship-funded path to the top levels of motorsports.

- Ladder series to INDY NXT of the 25 drivers that made INDY NXT starts in 2023, only three were not USF Pro graduates
- Of the average 27-car NTT INDYCAR SERIES 2023 starting grid, 13 drivers were USF Pro graduates including Pato O'Ward, Colton Herta, Kyle Kirkwood, Felix Rosenqvist, Rinus VeeKay and David Malukas
- Four consecutive USF Pro 2000 champions have graduated to INDYCAR

USF Juniors is the first official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system, providing an entry level program for young drivers needing more experience and track time before advancing up the ladder, and brings a level of professionalism and organization to a driver's first serious championship choice.

The series champion will earn a scholarship valued at \$263,700 to advance to USF2000 in 2025.

Skip Barber, the Official Racing School of USF Pro Championships, will continue to offer its Formula Race Series champion a scholarship valued at \$100,000 to advance to USF Juniors.



USF2000 is the second official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system.

The series has served as a formative step for drivers since 1990.

Drivers who have honed their skills in the series include Oliver Askew, Colton Herta, Sage Karam, Kyle Kirkwood, Hunter McElrea, Christian Rasmussen, Parker Thompson and Rinus VeeKay to name a few.

The series champion will earn a scholarship valued at \$458,400 to advance to USF Pro 2000 in 2025.



USF Pro 2000 is the third official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system.

The series is the penultimate step of the ladder program providing a scholarship valued at \$681,500 to advance to INDY NXT in 2025.

With roots dating back to 1991, USF Pro 2000 has been a vital step on the career path of many of today's top drivers including Conor Daly, Kyle Kirkwood, Pato O'Ward, Rinus VeeKay and recent champions Myles Rowe, Louis Foster and Christian Rasmussen.
