#### ABOUT USF PRO CHAMPIONSHIPS PRESENTED BY CONTINENTAL TIRE

USF Pro Championships Presented by Continental Tire is an evolution of the Road to Indy, one of the most successful driver development programs in the world. Comprised of USF Pro 2000 Presented by Continental Tire, USF2000 Presented by Continental Tire and USF Juniors Presented by Continental Tire, the ladder system provides a scholarship-funded path to the top levels of motorsports with over \$1.68M in scholarships, prize money and awards in 2024.

Of the average 27-car NTT INDYCAR SERIES 2023 starting grid, 13 drivers were USF Pro graduates including Pato O'Ward, Colton Herta, Kyle Kirkwood, Felix Rosenqvist, Rinus VeeKay and David Malukas. Of the 25 drivers that made INDY NXT starts in 2023, only three were not USF Pro graduates.

The racing world in general also featured series graduates including Oliver Askew, Austin Cindric, Townsend Bell, Gabby Chaves, Pipo Derani, Dakota Dickerson, Trent Hindman, Andy Lally, Michael McDowell, Bryan Sellers, Aaron Telitz, Parker Thompson and Tristan Vautier – all competing at the premier level in a variety of disciplines.

Since its launch in 2010, the ladder system has attracted competitors from around the globe with drivers representing 37 countries and six continents as part of its grids, showcasing their talents at premier venues on a mix of road courses, temporary street circuits and ovals.

USF Pro Championships provide its competitors an opportunity to gain valuable experience on and off the track while following a clear-cut path of progression.



#### **USF PRO CHAMPIONSHIPS**



USF Pro 2000 is the third official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system.

With roots dating back to 1991, USF Pro 2000 has been a vital step on the career path of many of today's top drivers including Conor Daly, Kyle Kirkwood, Pato O'Ward, Rinus VeeKay and recent champions Myles Rowe, Louis Foster and Christian Rasmussen.

The past six consecutive USF Pro 2000 champions have all graduated to INDY NXT or the NTT INDYCAR SERIES.



USF2000 is the second official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system. The series has served as a formative step for drivers since 1990.

Drivers who have honed their skills in the series include Oliver Askew, Colton Herta, Sage Karam, Kyle Kirkwood, Hunter McElrea. Christian Rasmussen. Parker Thompson and Rinus VeeKay, to name a few.



USF Juniors, which debuted in 2022, is the first official step on the USF Pro Championships driver development system. The series provide an entry level program for young drivers needing more experience and track time before advancing up the ladder, and brings a level of professionalism and organization to a driver's first serious championship choice.

Graduates include rising stars Mac Clark, Sam Corry, Nikita Johnson, Quinn Armstrong, Jack Jeffers and series champions Mac Clark and Nicolas Giaffone.

The same base Tatuus chassis is utilized in all three levels of USF Pro Championships, allowing drivers and teams to begin with the USF Juniors JR-23 and continue to advance up the world's most complete driver development system with a forward-thinking three-step concept.

The equipment package will remain in competition for at least four more seasons through 2027.



#### THE CHASSIS

Tatuus is world-renowned as a premier builder of formula cars. The USF Pro Championships concept is unique in that the same monocoque and many of the main suspension and bodywork components are common to all three series.

The chassis is a full carbon composite and aluminum honeycomb monocoque meeting current FIA safety standards including side impact panels, front and rear impact structures, HANS-compliant INDYCAR head restraint, front and rear wheel tethers and an upgraded front bulkhead structure for USA-specific oval racing circuits and a Halo-type device.
